COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES OF THE SHARON HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL May 20, 2021 @ 7:00PM

Meeting called to order by Vice President Booker

Roll Call: Roll call was answer as follows:

Vice President Booker read a statement see attached:

I indicated that I realized that I misspoke when answering a question that was asked from the audience in a portion where it says that a meeting occurred where a public safety issue I should have said a personal safety concern. If that could be reflected and amended in the minutes I would appreciate it.

Mr. Martinez asked if council was able to review the email that he sent to everyone last week about the personnel matter in the executive session he requested last week. If so is it possible to have a vote?

Ms. Cavalieri has reviewed it.

Mrs. Bedford Dean only had the one email from Keith not the one from Bill.

Mr. Martinez that is what I sent to everyone.

Mrs. Bedford Dean I only got the first. Was the first contract sent out?

Mr. Martinez yes it was.

Mrs. Bedford Dean I didn't get that can you send it to me.

Mr. Martinez yes I can.

Mrs. Bedford Dean after I have read it we can... Because we have until December so we can give time for everybody to read it. Mr. Felder did you have time to read it? Do you have a copy?

Vice President Booker asked councilman to send it out to everyone so that we can have all the documentation so that we can make a decision.

Mr. Martinez I know Mr. Smith sent out.

Mr. Smith we both sent them out last Friday.

Mr. Martinez yes.

Mrs. Bedford Dean the only thing that I received was from you Keith and that was the amendment.

Mr. Martinez ok that is the one I spoke about in executive session and Mr. Smith sent out another email last week.

Vice President Booker Mr. Smith will you please re-send that email to all of council so we can get a copy.

Mr. Smith I will do so right after the meeting.

No questions for Mr. Martinez.

Mrs. Bedford Dean has nothing to report.

No questions for Mrs. Bedford Dean.

Vice President Booker SHACC had a very nice flea market last week and we will continue to do that every 3rd Saturday of the month. We are also going to be doing Sunday Jazz in the park. WE are going to be doing a series of Jazz concerts beginning in June. We will let you know what day in June probably the 2nd Sunday in June. We will keep you updated and we hope that everyone will come out and attend. We are also going to be doing a Juneteenth celebration which will include some other activities and we will post that on the board and sending out a notification through all the media outlets.

Mr. Smith read the Treasurers report and the Bills list. See attached:

Ms. Cavalieri noticed that you took off the television company.

Mr. Smith yes that was discussed at last week's meeting.

Ms. Cavalieri asked about the bill that does the Boro code. So that bill covers the ordinances that were outstanding?

Mr. Smith yes once we pay that bill they will update that for us and the whole process should be done in about 3-4 weeks. They will send us new code books for the borough to use and they will also be coordinating with our webmaster to update it online over the next couple of weeks.

Vice President Booker is getting emails from residents stating that they are not able to submit any information or submit questions online to our borough website and we need to look at that.

Mr. Smith we are getting questions on a regular basis from the website. If there is a resident having an issue have them call the office and we can take their concern over the phone or help them get it through the website but we are getting that through the website.

Vice President Booker asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report totaling \$212,060.03.

Do we have a motion to approve the bill list?

Motion made by Mr. Martinez second by Ms. Cavalieri. No questions. All in favor? Opposed? Motion carries 5-0.

Mayor Dunfee?

Mr. Smith I only had a couple of items. The plumbing issue in borough hall has been rectified. Today was our pop up vaccine clinic at the Ridley Ave parking lot it went pretty well. They took care of a couple of employees as well. I want to thank the council for supporting that.

Vice President Booker asked that a thank you letter be sent to them for including us.

Vice President Booker asked if there was any information about any grants.

Mr. Smith at the moment no we didn't get our DCBG grant funding from the county this year we were turned down. I continue to look for anything that we can do. I am working on getting the applications in to make sure we get our corona virus relief money that the municipalities are getting. We are supposed to get that money hopefully by the end of May.

Vice President Booker asked about the status of the TV.

Mr. Smith they were contacted. Hopefully they will set up an appointment next week to see what is going on there. They are also going to see why it's not getting pushed out to the cable provider. That is why we are holding off on paying the bill until we get that up and running.

Vice President Booker what is our status Bill? Are we Green?

Mr. Smith yes the tax collector has dropped lots of money on us and we are good to go.

Vice President Booker the Sharon Hill Borough is green.

I see an e mail that Mayor Dunfee is on the call.

Mayor Dunfee read the police Chief's report. See attached:

Ms. Cavalieri asked about the domestics. Is there anything that we can do to raise awareness or help people that are experiencing it? 48 is a high number.

Chief Herron we do send our officers to training. We try to express to the residents when we go to calls resources for the. I have been working with Vice President Booker I know she is a big advocate of it and we are trying to get the word out there through our resources and what we have.

Vice President Booker would like to meet with the Chief next week sometime so that we can come up with a plan.

Chief Herron yes Ma'am.

No further questions.

Mr. Schleigh has nothing to report.

Vice President Booker stated that there will be an executive session after the meeting and we will be sending council an invite for that session.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Pat Rumaker 35 Greenwood Rd. Last week a woman said that we shouldn't talk over each other which I totally agree before I was able to ask my second question someone else was allowed to talk so that really ticked me off. I know Facebook is not the be all to end all but on Facebook I saw that you could get minutes of the meeting. Where do you get the minutes of the meeting because I'm good at computers. I cannot find it on Sharon Hill's website at all. Where is it located?

Mr. Smith they are on the website once they are approved. The drop down I believe is under departments. It should be a separate section for minutes and on the borough website and as we have done before for residents once they are approved by council if you want a copy if you just ask us at borough hall we just run you off a copy for you it's not a problem.

Pat Rumaker 35 Greenwood Rd. I asked for a copy one time and I was told I would have to pay \$1 a page and I am not paying \$1 a page because I thought they were supposed to be public record.

Mr. Smith give me a call in the office in the morning and I'll be happy to walk you through it.

Pat Rumaker 35 Greenwood Rd. I'll be able to figure it out. I was a secretary for 28 years so I know my way around a computer. My second question is and this may not be able to be answered. Where do you get a list of who won the election Tuesday? I know it was all on the democratic side but I can't find any of the wright in's on the republican side.

Vice President Booker you can contact the bureau of elections because that is handled at the county level. The county has an election website.

Pat Rumaker 35 Greenwood Rd. So Sharon Hill is not going to put on who won the elections?

Vice President Booker there is a community page which is called Sharon Hill Community Page and it is posted there and also on my web page on Facebook and you can look at it there.

Ms. Cavalieri just wanted to add that when she went out just now she couldn't not find it. It might need to get updated.

Vice President Booker would also like all residents to keep in mind that they will be a month prior because we cannot post the minutes until they are approved by council so the April minutes should be going up because they were just approved. The March minutes should be up and I will also be posting the minutes once they are approved on the Sharon Hill Borough Community Page if anyone is interested in seeing that.

Charlotte Walsh 113 Brainerd Blvd. Is the borough code subcontracted? You pay someone to come in and facilitate that? The code inspections?

Vice President Booker that is not what they are talking about. The code is like a manifest that tells all boroughs how to operate and that is what he is referring to when he talks about the borough code. It's a document.

Charlotte Walsh 113 Brainerd Blvd. Where can we find a copy of that?

Vice President Booker there is a website. It's the PA Borough Code. All municipalities form their own documents from the Borough Code. There will be a physical copy at the borough hall and it will also be located on the website.

Mr. Smith there is a copy on the website now but it will get updated.

Vice President Booker it will take 3-4 weeks is that correct?

Mr. Smith yes.

Vice President Booker for anyone that is interested there is a copy on our Sharon Hill Borough website and the updated version will be available in the next 3-4 weeks.

Charlotte Walsh 113 Brainerd Blvd. I wanted to ask about the flea market. The tables cost \$25. What is done with the funds?

Vice President Booker that goes to the Sharon Hill Art and Culture Commission and we use that for programs that we provide to our residents free of charge.

Charlotte Walsh 113 Brainerd Blvd. Ok great thank you.

Ms. Cavalieri just wanted to follow Ms. Walsh question. I put the link to the borough codes in the chat if you want to click it there but it is available on the borough site and that is what Mr.

Smith was saying that it does not reflect the updates that the company is making for us now but if you want to see the existing Boro code as it is the link is in the chant and as far do we contract for code enforcement services at present we do. We have not filled that role yet but to clarify that wasn't what he was talking about but to answer your question yes we do currently contract out code enforcement services.

Kate Flatly 72 Clifton Ave. I live across the street from the post office and I noticed the street sweeper for the parking lot across the street goes by 11-2am in the morning. It's just terrible and in the spring time even now with the windows open it's just awful. I know they can't do it during the day but cars are parked there but it's terrible to do it in the middle of the night. The other thing is the speed limit on Clifton Ave. no one looks at. They come flying over that bridge from Collingdale and I just hear them and then they are flying across the bridge going up the hill to Collingdale. A few years ago when I complained they did reduce the speed limit from 35 to 25mph but that means nothing and now at night it seems like because it wakes me up that people are drag racing on Chester Pike between 11-2am. They are also... And then coming up over bridge to Collingdale and they go down and around Darby and start it again. Besides the fact that it's noisy and it wakes me up it's very scary. I expect to wake up some night with the sound of a massive crash. I just want to bring that up.

Vice President Booker asked the Chief if he is able to have some officers monitor that time.

Chief Herron yes we will take care of that.

Vice President Booker and as far as the speed limit can we try to enforce that better based on her information that would be fantastic.

Mike Ropski 844 Elmwood Ave. Mr. Smith do you have an update for the property behind us that tree company.

Mr. Smith nothing current. I know that the property has been significantly cleaned up. As far as we can tell it's been relatively quiet. I don't know if the solicitor has anything to add or not but generally it's been pretty quiet. I do have on my list for the commercial code inspector to go back there and take a look next week other than that it has been cleaned up significantly and I know Mayor Dunfee was involved in that as well. I don't know if Mr. Schleigh or Mr. Dunfee want to add to that.

Mr. Schleigh I'm not aware that there are any continuing violations. If council would like me to do anything I would be glad to help.

Vice President Booker Sir are you looking for an update or is there something that you would like to report?

Mike Ropski 844 Elmwood Ave. I just wanted to get an update I know that you had the architects and engineers go back there due to the erosion issues and stuff like that and the

containers and the building I was just wondering is that an official structure there? Is that in compliance? I was not aware that you could build a structure using containers so I was just trying to get an update to find out if there was a code out there.

Mr. Smith everything back there as far as we know is up to compliance. Our code enforcers are aware of the construction of it and they have been back there several times over the last couple of months as we have been rectifying it. AS soon as we hear back from our code officer when re re-visits there I'll update the council at the June 10th meeting.

Mike Ropski 844 Elmwood Ave. What about the lights and the containers is that permanent?

Mr. Smith I don't know that they are going to stay there. I don't know if he submitted a lighting plan yet. I know all the other work we made them do might have curtailed that for a minute because he had a lot of clean up to do. The containers is one of the issues that our code inspector is going to get back to us on when he goes back there next week. It's on his list to get done by the end of the month.

Mike Ropski 844 Elmwood Ave. The lighting is already done. The lights are hitting the back of the properties. The lights should be adjusted to the property.

Mr. Smith if that hasn't been done I'll make sure that it gets done again I'm not aware of any further issues but if it needs to get done we will get it done.

Mike Ropski 844 Elmwood Ave. What about the erosion issues. Has that been taken care of or is that ok?

Mr. Smith Again at the moment I believe it's ok. I'm not sure if they plan to seed that lot because of the nature of the business. I know getting the containers out of there was a part of that issue as well so that is being worked on.

Mike Ropski 844 Elmwood Ave. So is everything ok.

Mr. Smith I said they are working on it.

Vice President Booker Mr. Ropski we will have an update for you at our next meeting.

Robert Hubbs 68 Clifton Ave. I have noticed an alarming increase of teenagers fighting around our area in both the alley behind my house and in the parking lot across the street next to the post office and to Amelia's. Is there something maybe that we can do to keep them from quell them from gathering up and starting fights with each other?

Vice President Booker call the police.

Robert Hubbs 68 Clifton Ave. Yes but maybe... I haven't seen like the police in... They use to patrol in the back alleyway every so often but I have not seen them lately making their patrols around here maybe I'm just not looking at the right times I don't know I'm not looking for them but I haven't noticed them lately.

Vice President Booker Chief # 1 when is the bike patrol going to begin?

Chief Herron the bike patrol will begin sometime after Memorial Day. I'm on the phone with Corporal Attix our night time supervisor and we have not received any calls for fights in that area in a while and Corporal Attix has stated that he has been in that area and has not observed anything but we will keep an extra eye up there for that.

Vanessa Doyle 333 Oak Ave. I'm curious about the community garden I see was mentioned on Facebook. Is that real? Is it really happening?

Vice President Booker yes we actually do have a community garden and we have been having a hard time getting someone from the horticultural society to come out and look at it to tell us what kind of plants that we can Actually put down and we have put it on hold and we hope to really be able to have a grand opening next month. We had planned to do it the first week in June but we really want to be able to have somebody who has ample knowledge about that to come out to talk to us when we do the grand opening. I have reached out to other communities that have community gardens and I'm waiting to hear back from them and as soon as I know something I'll let you know.

Vanessa Doyle 333 Oak Ave. Will we be allowed to volunteer to work it? I have my own vegetable garden ever since I have lived here so I know a little bit.

Vice President Booker absolutely. And since you are volunteering we have our Art and Culture Commission meetings every 1st Wednesday of the month at 7pm. We will be doing it live next month and I will let you know where that is going to be and we certainly hope that you will come out and share some of your ideas.

Vanessa Doyle 333 Oak Ave. Absolutely. Thank you very much.

Vice President Booker if you could put your email address in the chat I can contact you.

Ms. Cavalieri there was a question in the chat from Sheila Carter asking is the code enforcement job a current opening?

Mr. Smith at the moment there are no openings. Linn Architects has that filled but if that is something that you want to re-visit we can do that.

Vice President Booker the answer to that is moment no but council will be re-visiting that issue.

Pat Rumaker 335 Greenwood Rd. Where exactly is this garden?

Vice President Booker it is at Chester and Ridley Pike. In the back of the house at Chester and Ridley Pike. It'd just 3 plots right now and we haven't put up a banner or anything because again we are just trying to do it as properly as we can with as much information as we can to try to figure out what we can do. It's not a big space but it's ours.

Pat Rumaker 335 Greenwood Rd. Ok so it's somebody's back yard or?

Vice President Booker it does belong to the Medical office on the corner but it is our space. It was donated for Sharon Hill.

Pat Rumaker 335 Greenwood Rd. I am aware of that. I kept looking and I said I don't see any gardens.

Vice President Booker I took pictures of it and I will re-post it. You can also go to the Sharon Hill Art and Culture site on Facebook and there are some pictures on there as well.

Julie Hubbs 68 Clifton Ave. I tried to notify the borough before and the police department several times I'm not happy with the speeders that go down our alley way. There are too many kids that play in that alleyway including mine and they speed down there like it's a highway and my kid has almost been hit twice and I have already borough this up with the borough and I have brought it up with the police department. They use to send up a police officer every so often but they haven't been doing that lately.

Vice President Booker certainly our police will be addressing it but also our bike police will be starting next week is the holiday and after the holiday he said that the bike patrol will be starting and hopefully we can eliminate some of that.

Chief Herron yes we will have our bike troll will be out to keep the area checked.

Tracey Turner 200 Laurel Rd. When are we going to be getting speed bumps? I know they were supposed to be coming in when the weather got nice but I haven't seen any anywhere.

Mr. Smith the speed bump on Coates St. should be down by Monday and then we will put the one over on Greenwood Rd area probably Tuesday or Wednesday of next week.

Mr. Martinez that was one of my new business questions.

Vice President Booker any old business? Any new business?

Ms. Cavalieri a couple months ago by the advice of our solicitor I started working on the codification of our parking ordinances and I got a response back from the police chief. I didn't

hear back from the fire company but I wanted to ask is this something that we want to park at the moment or should I push effort into that?

Vice President Booker I would say to continue to put effort into it because it is an ongoing project.

Ms. Cavalieri anyone else have thoughts on it?

Vice President Booker and we could probably ask... Mr. Smith can you contact the fire department and ask them if they could please respond to Ms. Cavalieri.

Mr. Smith yes Ma'am.

Ms. Cavalieri I want to take a moment and I have personally thanked these people and I would like to thank the citizens of Sharon Hill that worked the polls because it is a thankless job. It's a long day but they do it and are gracious about it and I wanted to thank everyone that came out on Election Day. The other thing I wanted to share with the community is we have a summer entertainment series in the works. WE want to bring to Sharon Hill some events where we will be able to get together outdoors and enjoy ourselves which will include acts, music and movie night. I just want to put that out there so that you know there is something coming that we can do together as a community and the last thing I wanted to share we have some 4th of July week events coming see attached:

Mr. Martinez These questions are for Mr. Smith:

Q. Last week I spoke to you about a code concern on greenwood and I just want to know if code went out and addressed this situation and if they did what was the outcome?

A. They did visit the property. Off the top of my head I do not know what the result was but I can circle back to you in the morning.

A. The other thing was the speed bumps and I see on the bill list that the anchors were purchased and you mentioned to Mrs. Turner that the Highway Department was short so that answers my question so the speed bumps are in and they are going to start getting installed.

A. Yes I had one put down a couple of days ago.

Q. The issue with the mulch at Memorial Park. I am concerned about somebody getting hurt and the borough being liable and if there is a certain depth and measurement from the bottom of the swings and the sliding boards that needs to be rectified so that we are not being held liable. I am a big safety person in the safety of our residents and want to make sure we are safe. When was the last time that was mulched and when can we get it re-mulched so that it's ADA compliant.

A. I believe it was 2 summers ago and you are right it needs to be done. WE will have the highway guys work on that as soon as possible. They also need to repair some of the rubber bumpers around there and I also had them fix some swings recently at the rec center and Memorial Park. WE will look into the mulch and get that corrected.

Q. I have noticed that the trash men have been dumping it. They have been doing a prenominal job but I have noticed there have been incidents where they are leaving trash that

has been spilled out on the street. I don't know if we can reach out to them and say hey you need to make sure that you have a shovel and broom on the back because glass, trash and plastic has been left in the borough. I noticed that they are throwing cans. I have seen them pick up trash cans and actually place them inside the back of the truck and dump them whereas your trash everything possible that people throw out you are exposing the actual cans even though they are trash cans but we are picking those cans up and putting them in our yard. I have also witnessed them pulling bags out of trash cans and literally dropping them in the street when the trash truck is backing up the street and the guy is loading up out in front of residences houses and they are picking the bags out of the trash can and literally dropping it on the ground which could be subject to the trash bags busting open and staining the streets and they are not really picking up behind it and the trucks that they are using are actually staining up our borough streets. I noticed on my block and I have noticed other blocks in the borough and I don't know what is causing it and I know it's a trash truck and stuff happens but the entire 2 blocks just look horrible. I don't know if there is anything that we can do about that but I would just love to reach out to them and say hey if you drop something on the ground just pick it up because it is trash and like I said about throwing the cans and just tossing them. I get it they are hustling and trying to get it done but they need to be respectful with the trash cans and be mindful to pick up after themselves when coming down the street.

Mr. Smith I hear your concerns. We are in regular contact with them on a number of issues. I will make them aware of your concerns first thing in the morning.

Mr. Martinez they work very hard but these are the things that I have noticed not only as a councilman but as a resident to me it's not acceptable especially leaving trash in the street.

Mr. Smith will look intro that and their trucks and let you know.

Ms. Cavalieri if I could circle back to the 4th of July. I will say councilman Martinez I am going to try on Saturday to clean up the stain on my street from the trash trucks so if it works I'll let you know because I know my block and Reese street also have some stains from the trucks. The 4th of July celebration week see attached schedule:

We do not have a parade scheduled for this year I'm sorry to say but hopefully these events will be fun and a way to ease us back to our normal ways of celebrating the 4th of July.

Mr. Martinez The amount of trash at the basketball courts has been significant even though we have ample trash receptacles inside the courts the occupants choose not to use them however I noticed on Monday that the trash was picked up inside the courts but the parking lot trash was not picked up. Once again Mr. Smith I know you said that the highway department is short and I understand that but for future... They did pick up today. I did see Kenny and Kevin Anthony out there today ad they picked up the trash in the parking lot. Monday they picked up in the courts but the actual parking lot was not picked up so I just want to put that out there. I just want to make sure that they are monitoring the entire area including the parking lot.

Mr. Smith they are going to be out there every morning due to the amount of trash that id there.

Mr. Martinez I know in the past it was certain days but I wanted to ask if they could monitor that on a daily basis.

Mr. Felder there is a lot of leaves that have accumulated on Barker and Wall Way. There is a sewer grate that has a lot of leaves it's clogging the drain. There is also a pair of sneakers on the wire.

Mr. Smith we will get those taken care of as well.

Rodney Hill 326 Laurel Rd. Are there particular streets assigned to get the speed bumps?

Mr. Smith yes.

Rodney Hill 326 Laurel Rd. There are a lot of speeding down my block coming off of Poplar and my car and my neighbors car got hit twice from these speeding cars and I called the police and they did come out and take a report and I thank them for that. A lot of the residents have kids and I'm wondering if we could get a speed bump on Laurel Rd and also on Poplar. Last week a gentleman was crossing the street and the guy hit him and kept going. It was really loud and we ran around the corner to see what happened but the driver took off. They drive at a high rate of speed on Poplar as well. I would greatly appreciate it if that can be looked into. I would love to have one on my block as well. The other question I have for the police chief for the past 2 weeks I have been hearing gun shots going off and I'm not sure if those gun shots are in Sharon Hill or somewhere nearby. Have you heard anything about that?

Chief Herron we have not had any complaints of gun shots in town for a while knock on wood. I know that neighboring towns have been having problems with fireworks that are down in that are that they are trying to squash. We have not had any gun shots or victims of gun shots or anything like that.

Rodney Hill 326 Laurel Rd. I just want to bring that to your attention.

Chief Herron I had a meeting with another town today regarding fireworks and they are trying to squash that.

Rodney Hill 326 Laurel Rd. Is it possible to look at the speed bumps for Laurel and Poplar?

Mr. Smith Poplar is one of the roads and we are going to be getting some other blocks.

Vice President Booker asked Mr. Smith to look into trash being left on Calcon hook Rd across from the gas station.

I need a motion to adjourn

Mr. Schleigh asked Vice President Booker to state the topic of the executive session.

Vice President Booker stated it was a personnel issue.

My Fellow Sharon Hill Citizens:

It has come to the attention of your elected officials that personal information of Councilwoman LaTina Bedford-Dean and her family were released in response to a Right to Know request. Such release of information was improper and the Borough apologizes for this disclosure. Portions of the documents were relevant to Library expenses subject to reimbursement and others were purely personal and did not use public funds.

DCED Awards MAP Grant Funding to Assist with Chester Pike Corridor Master Plan

On April 21, 2021, the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) announced the approval of \$100,000 in funding for the preparation of a Chester Pike Corridor Master Plan project through the Municipal Assistance Program (MAP). The Delaware County Planning Department, in cooperation with the Chester Pike Corridor Improvement Partners (CPCIP), a 501c3 corporation dedicated to the revitalization of the Chester Pike Corridor, will develop a multi-municipal Corridor Master Plan for the Boroughs of Sharon Hill, Glenolden, Norwood, Prospect Park, and Ridley Park.

"The first step in ensuring the continued growth and success of a community is developing a comprehensive plan that addresses and anticipates both established and emerging needs," said Linda Hill, Director of the Delaware County Planning Department. "This critical funding will help these five boroughs create and implement the plans that will allow them to be more effective today and more prepared for tomorrow."

Known locally as Chester Pike, the four-and-a-half-mile segment of U.S. Route 13 serves as either a Main Street or connector to the town center of each of the five boroughs. The aging corridor needs significant engineering and design enhancements to the road, bus, and rail transit infrastructure. Complete Streets planning and design will be used to improve pedestrian and bicycle facilities to make the corridor a safer and more accessible destination. Additionally, prominent older buildings in the corridor suffer from vacancies and neglect and require redevelopment, adaptive reuse, or facade improvements. Revitalization of the Chester Pike Corridor will be used to attract a more diverse mix of commercial and other uses and to position the corridor to benefit from the economic recovery anticipated as the region and the nation emerges from the COVID-19 pandemic.






