Caucus Meeting Minutes

Call To Order/Pledge of Allegiance, 7:15pm

Roll Call: Present, Council President Tanya Allen (TA), Vice President Keith Martinez (KM), Councilors, Sharon Booker (SB), William Felder (WF), Rodney Hill (RH), Sandra Holcombe (SH), Borough Manager Barbarann Keffer (BA) excused; Mayor Hykeem Green (HG), Office Coordinator Celandra Rice-Adeloye (CRA) Police Chief Herron; Solicitor Courtney Richardson (CR)
